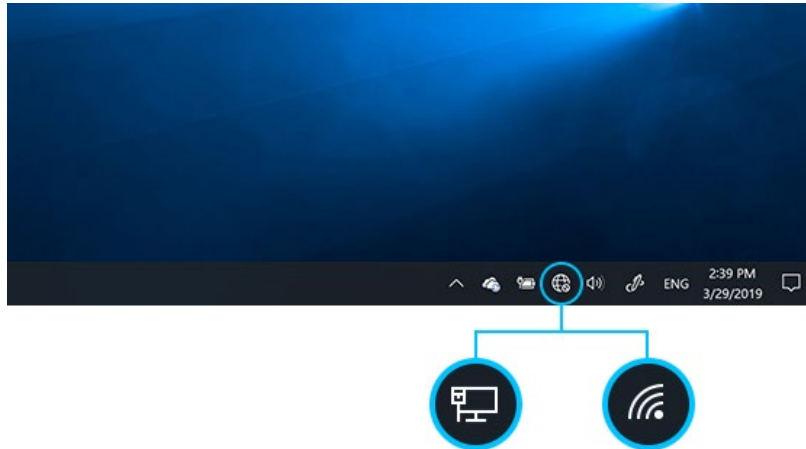


ONUnet – ONU Setup Guide for Windows 10

The steps below are designed to help Students, Faculty, and Staff connect to the wireless network at Olivet Nazarene University called ONU on Windows 10 (Guests should use ONUGuest).

1. Select the Network icon on the taskbar in the lower left corner. The icon that appears depends on your current connection state. If you don't see one of the network icons (or a similar one) shown in the following image, select the Up arrow to see if it appears there.

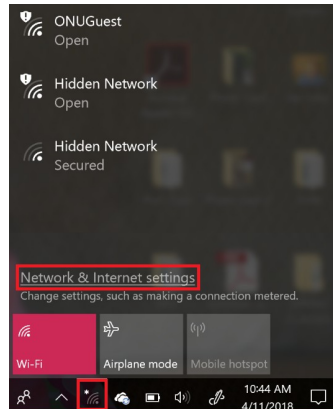


2. Choose the ONU network from the list of available networks, then select Connect.
3. Type in your ONU username (without @olivet.edu) ONU password, and then select Next.
4. Choose No on the prompt making your PC discoverable to others on the network.
5. Open a Web browser (Chrome, Edge, Firefox, etc.) to make sure you are connected.

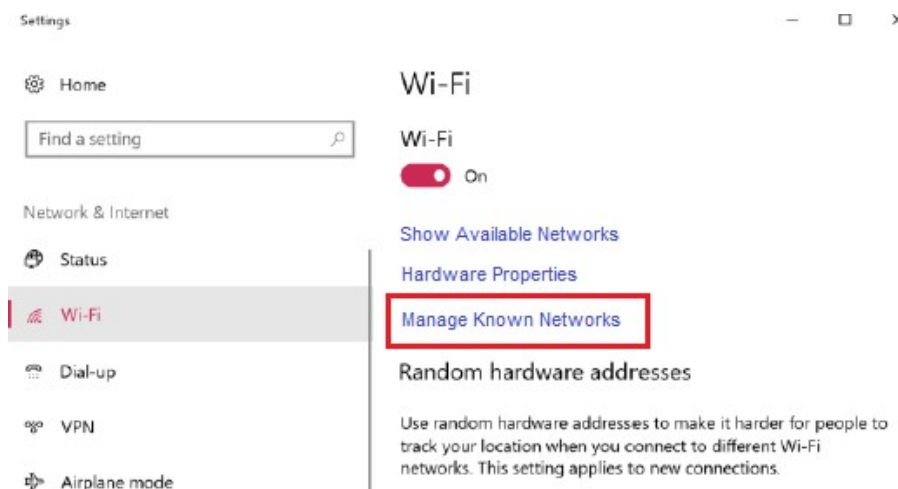

Older Windows 10 Versions

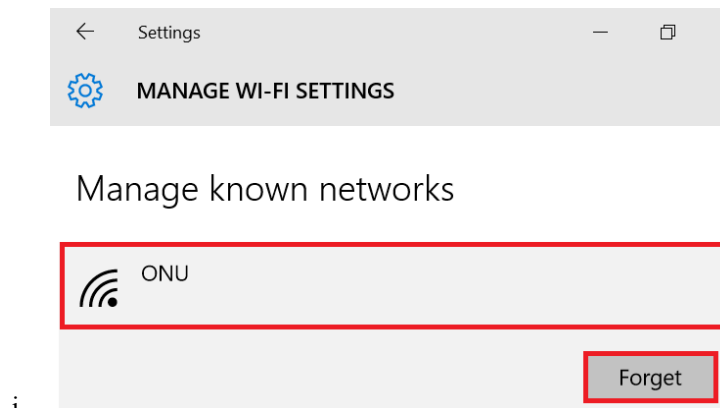
1. Click on the network icon in the task bar and click “Network & Internet settings”



2. Click “Manage Known Networks”



3. Click on the network you want to remove, then click forget. You can close out the network windows afterwards. Forget all of the following networks: ONU, Solomon, Judah, and ONUGuest



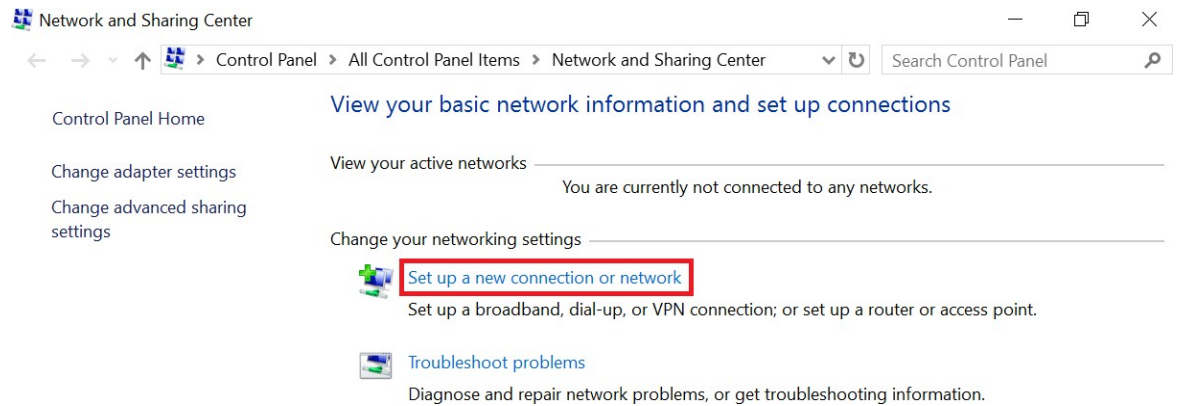

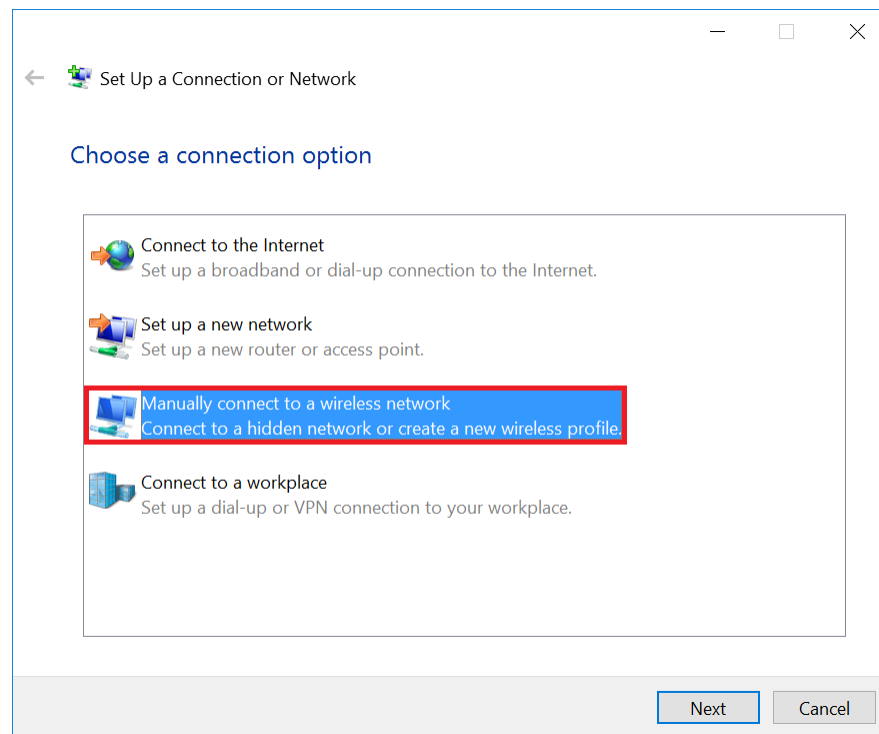
4. Go back to Settings, scroll down on the right and click "Network and Sharing Center."



5. Click "Set up a new connection or network"



6. Click "Manually connect to a wireless network"

7. Enter the Network name as: “ONU” (make sure to capitalize ONU)
8. Change Security Type to “WPA2-Enterprise”
9. Encryption type should be “AES”
10. Make sure that the checkbox next to “Start this connection automatically” is checked
11. Make sure that the checkbox next to “Connect even if the network is not broadcasting” is checked
12. Click “Next”

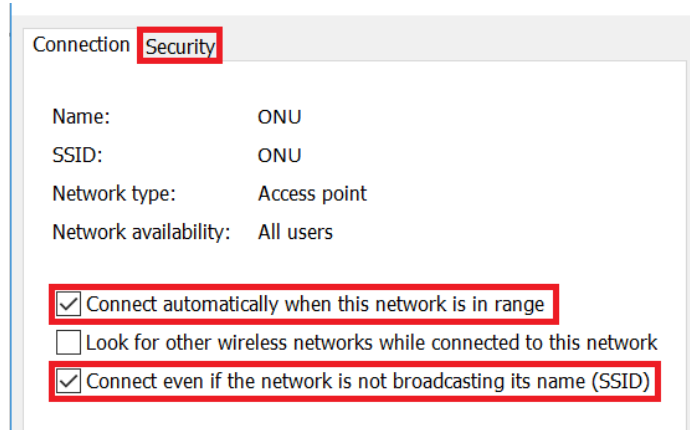

13. Click “Change connection settings”

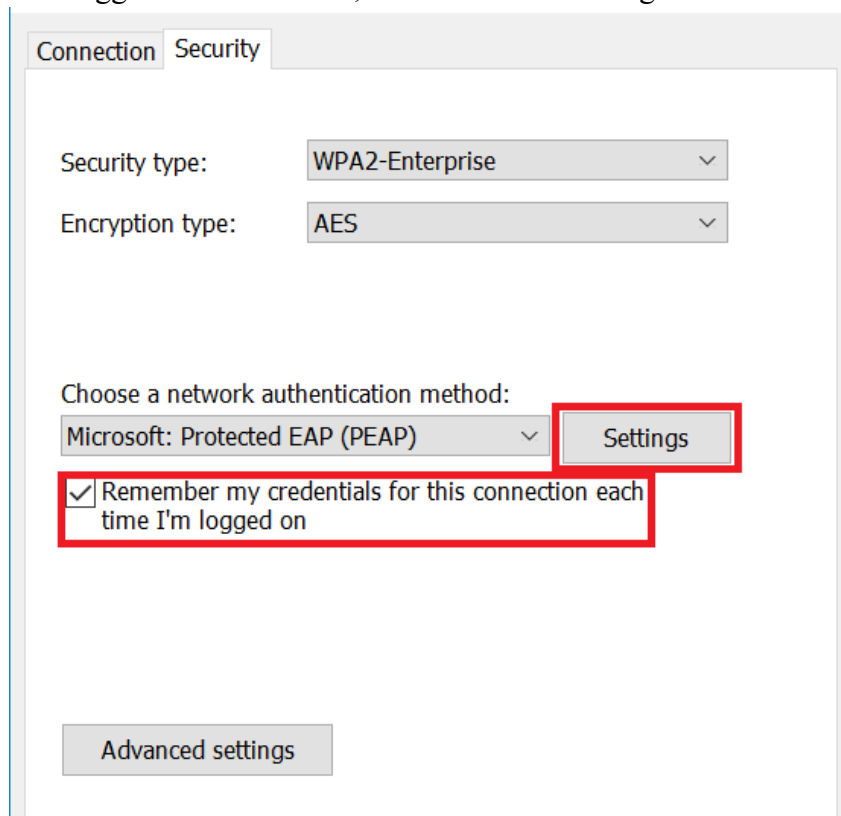

14. Make sure that the checkboxes next to “Connect automatically when this network is in range” and “Connect even if the network is not broadcasting its name (SSID)” are checked, then click the “Security” tab

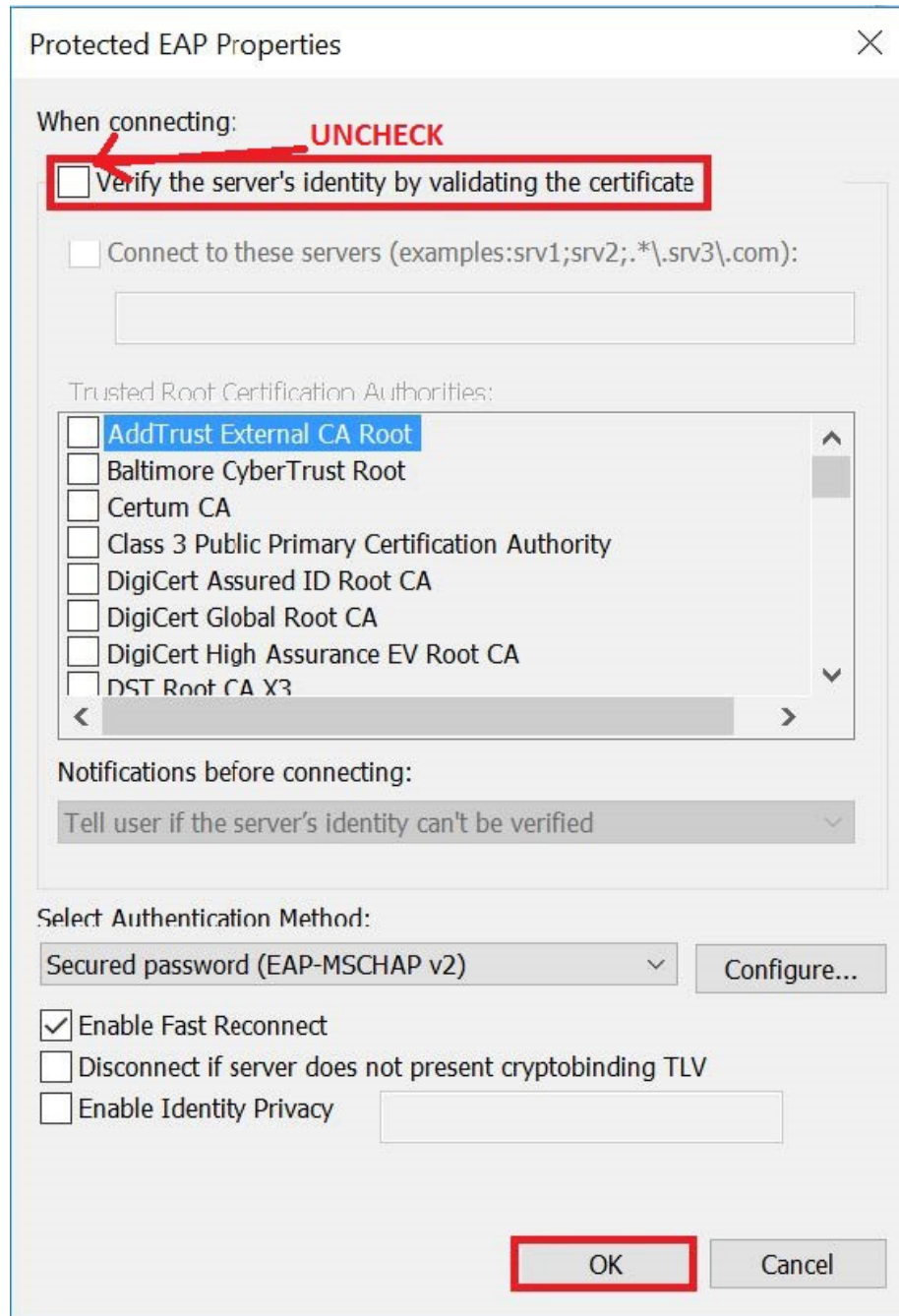


15. Make sure that the checkbox next to “Remember my credentials for this connection each time I’m logged on” is checked, then click the “Settings” button



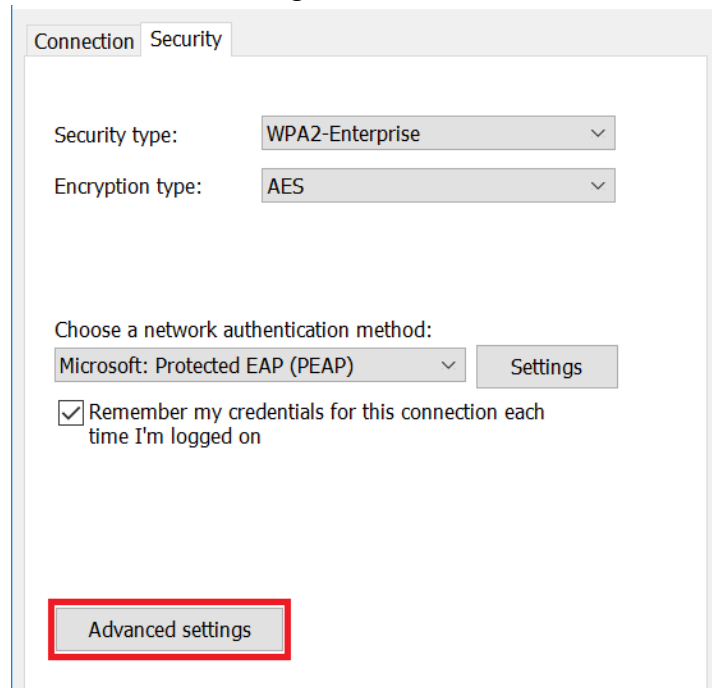

16. Uncheck the “Verify the server’s identity by validating the certificate” checkbox, then click
17. "OK."

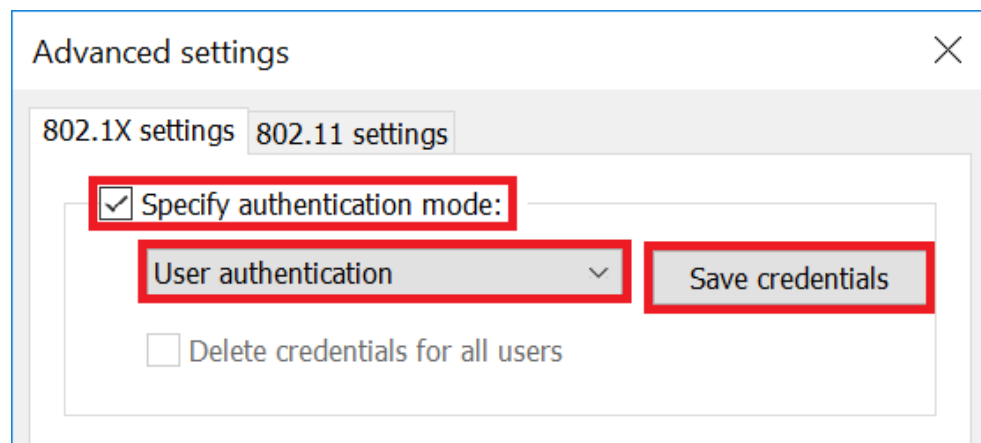
18. Click on the “Advanced Settings” button



19. Check the “Specify authentication mode:” box

20. Choose “User Authentication”

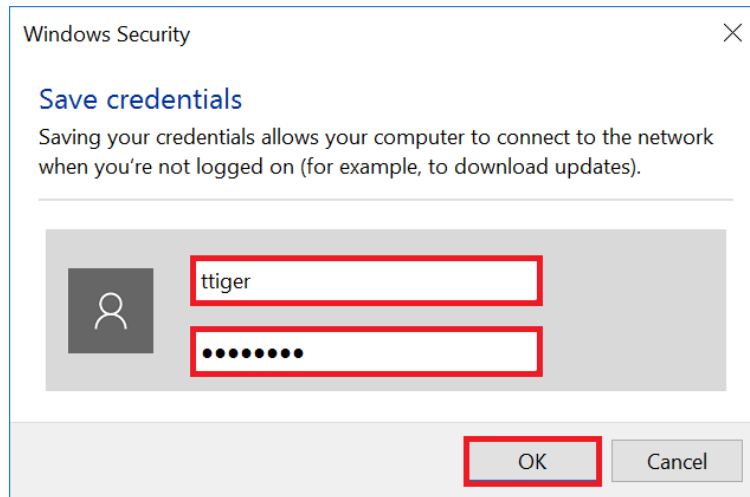
21. Click “Save credentials”



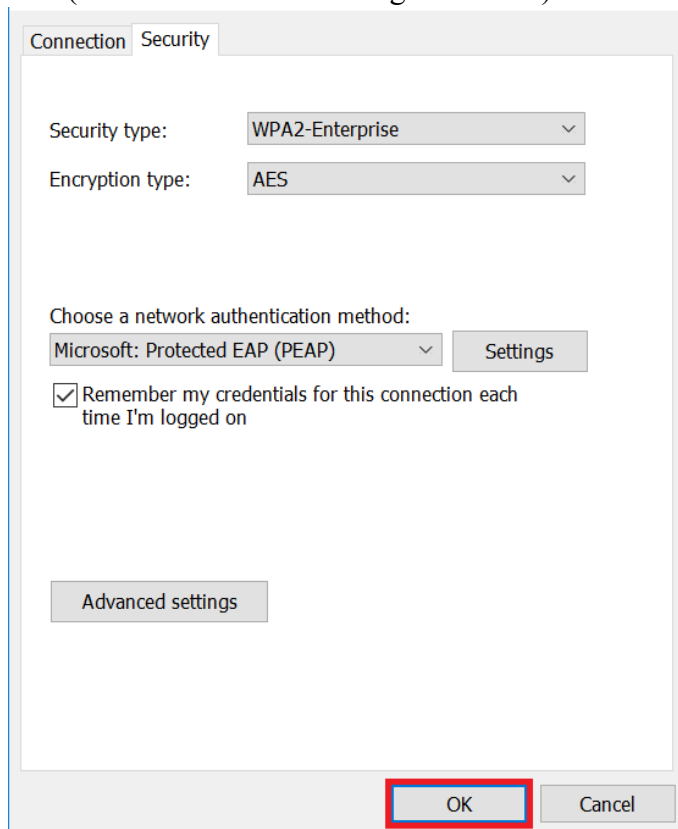

22. Type your ONUnet username and password (do not include "@olivet.edu")

23. Click “OK” (on the “Windows Security” window)



24. Click “OK” (on the “Advanced Settings” window)

25. Click “OK” (on the “ONU Wireless Network Properties” window)
26. Click “Close” (on the “Manually Connect to a Wireless Network” window)
27. Close out of the “Network and Sharing Center” window
28. Open a Web browser (Chrome, Edge, Firefox, etc.) to make sure you are connected
